I. SOVIET JEWRY ROLL CALL

Chrustowski delivered the Soviet Jewry Roll Call.

II. DEATH PENALTY

Friebert reported on the revised draft and moved for its adoption. Motion was seconded. Glazer moved that further deliberation is needed and that the position be referred to the Commission on Law & Jewish Security. Motion was seconded, then defeated. The original motion to adopt the revised position was passed.

III. FAMILY & MEDICAL LEAVE ACT

Gendelman gave a detailed report on the Act and moved that the Council approve its passage. Motion was seconded. Friesler moved to amend the motion by stating the Council supports the concept of a family and medical leave act philosophically, but to refrain from supporting any particular Act of Congress. Motion as amended was seconded and carried.

IV. ARAB-JEWISH RELATIONS IN ISRAEL

Schoenfeld moved for the adoption of the position stating that both the Executive Committee and the Commission on Israel voted to approve the position. Chernof seconded. Glazer stated that in the first paragraph where Israeli society is mentioned, he felt it necessary to note in the minutes that Israeli encompasses the Palestinian and Arab society as well.
