POLICY ON JEWISH EDUCATION
April 21, 1967

The Milwaukee Jewish Council as Milwaukee's Jewish community relations agency is charged with the responsibility of educating the community with respect to its goals of equal opportunity, human rights, social and economic justice. It is vital for the fulfillment of its responsibility that there be an informed and committed Jewish community.

We are in particular concerned that Jewish youth now attending a variety of Jewish educational institutions in Milwaukee understand more clearly the nature of these goals, and how Judaism and its religious and ethical traditions speak to them. The Milwaukee Jewish Council will cooperate with all institutions of Jewish education in the creation of imaginative programs of education and involvement in the critical problems of our city, state, and nation. Jewish youth is searching for meaningful opportunity to contribute to their society. Judaism, if it assists them in this quest, can become alive and relevant for them.

The Milwaukee Jewish Council offers its resources in cooperation with all institutions of Jewish education in Milwaukee.
