POLICY ON MINIMUM WAGE LEGISLATION

The Commission on Social and Economic Justice formulated the following draft at its meeting on March 22, 1989:

Whereas the Milwaukee Jewish Council, in its 1987 Principles on Welfare, established as a Board policy the need to assist the poor in our community to achieve self-sufficiency and to support strategies to reduce poverty and promote economic independence,

Therefore be it resolved that the Board of the Milwaukee Jewish Council support state and federal efforts to materially raise the minimum wage and oppose an unreasonably two-tiered, or probationary wage.
