POSITION ON AMENDMENT TO THE FEDERAL CONSTITUTION ON RELIGION:

Anti-Semitism and Constitutional Law Task Force Chair Robert Gordon said that the Christian Coalition has petitioned Congress to adopt a 10-point 'Contract with the American Family' which includes an amendment to permit religious activities in classrooms and public places which are currently prohibited by the First Amendment. Therefore, the Task Force and the Executive Committee recommended:

"The Council opposes any federal constitutional amendment that alters or supersedes the two religious rights clauses of the First Amendment."

Motion made and seconded to approve the recommendation. Motion adopted by unanimous consent. Tom Schneider and Karine Moreno Taxman abstained.
