## JCRC condemns religious persecution in Iraq

The Jewish Community Relations Council of the Milwaukee Jewish Federation is grateful to the United States in answering the cries the Christians, Yezidis, and other religious minorities who are being brutally targeted by extreme Islamic terrorist groups in Iraq.
