My dreams became a fantasy when I was taken to a Nazi labor camp at the age of 21. Today, at 94, I live by myself in a small apartment in Budapest, having lost the love of my life two decades ago. A recent stroke left me with constant tremors, partial blindness and deafness, and limited mobility. I also receive visits from social workers, and they make me feel like I'm not alone.



I saw first-hand how my donations to the Annual Campaign support families like Daniel's with trauma counseling and respite services.
