

Your Impact

Responding to need

- Serviced 37,600 clients at the Jewish Community Pantry
- Delivered 7,300 mental health counseling sessions
- Provided case management services to 500 of Milwaukee's Russian-speaking seniors
- Assisted hundreds of people left homeless after fires in Haifa

Building Jewish identity

- Served 10,000 free Shabbat dinners to college students
- Educated almost 900 children in Jewish day schools (PK-8)
- Reached nearly 500 students through Jewish youth groups
- Provided 240 hours of free training to Jewish educators

Pursuing a just world

- Assisted students at UW-Madison in combatting blatantly anti-Semitic rulings by the university's student council
- Taught the lessons of the Holocaust to 20,000 individuals across Wisconsin
- Invested in relationships through the Catholic-Jewish Conference, Latino-Jewish Alliance, Presbyterian-Jewish Dialogue, the Islamic Society of Milwaukee and more
- Responded to dozens of incidents of anti-Semitism across the state

Creating financial security

- Managed \$178 million in investments on behalf of donors and Jewish organizations through our Jewish Community Foundation
- Raised \$6.22 million to support the community through our 2017 Annual Campaign
- Secured 700 legacy commitments resulting in an estimated \$18 million in future gifts for synagogues, day schools and Jewish agencies
- Awarded more than \$600,000 in scholarships to local students and campers

Connecting with Israel

- Attracted 3,567 participants (1,000 more than last year) to Israel Center programs
- Collaborated with 37 local organizations, showing another side of Israel to the greater Milwaukee community
- Engaged more than 500 students with our Shlichah (cultural emissary) and her family, our Shin Shins (young cultural emissaries) and our Israel Campus Fellow
