Mayor Barrett presenting proclamation to celebrate Israel's 70th birthday

What: News conference on Israel's 70th

When: Thursday, April 19, 1 p.m.

MILWAUKEE, Wisconsin – Mayor Tom Barrett will present a proclamation to the Milwaukee Jewish community and interfaith groups in honor of Israel's 70 years of statehood during a news conference at 1 p.m. on Thursday, April 19 in the rotunda of City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.

April 19 marks the official day of Israel's statehood in 1948.
