


Afikoman

My grandparents taught my parents about the Seder. My parents are teaching me, and I will teach my children.




Haggadah

During the Seder we tell the story of the exodus from Egypt of the Children of Israel.




Jerusalem

We say the Kiddush before we drink each of the 4 cups of wine during the Seder.




Moses said to Pharaoh, "Let my people go!"




Maror We eat maror to remember the bitterness of slavery.



Nisan is the month in which Pesach comes.




Omer
We count the Omer for 49 days from Pesach to Shavuot.




Pesach Pesach is celebrated for 8 days.

We recline with a pillow during the Seder.




Seder


We hold Seders on the first two nights of Pesach.

We eat unleavened bread called matzah during Pesach.






Wine
