Camp Shalom - Junior Counselor

- Junior Counselors are under 18 and have completed 10th grade
- Starting at \$7.54/hr
- The Junior Counselor is responsible for the general safety and development, growth, and skill achievement of the campers in his/her group. They are also responsible for planning, leading, and implementing programs and experiences for children throughout the camp day. The Junior Counselor will provide high quality outdoor educational and recreational experiences for participants that focus on Camp Shalom's core values and make every day a great day. The Junior Counselor is a role model for campers and other staff members. This individual is a role model for staff and campers. The ideal candidate is building strong communication, teamwork and delegation skills, and has some experience working with children.

Essential Responsibilities

The Junior Counselor will:

- Collaborate with Co-Counselors and Counselors-In-Training for group cohesion and success
- Write and implement daily activities for your camp group ("group time") with your counselor team, including planning for supplies and making alternate plans for inclement weather.
- Keep track of all supplies.
- Help organize, lead, and provide support to other staff in a variety of small and large group activities.
- Identify and respond to camper behavior issues, and seek assistance when needed from Senior Counselors, Unit Heads, and Administrative Staff.
- Communicate with Camp Shalom Administrative Staff about camper experiences and report concerns
- Assist in maintaining accurate program records by filing incident reports, logbook documentation, and daily attendance.
- Learn and, as needed, follow through with emergency procedures.
- Learn, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines. This includes but is not limited to responsibility for camper safety at all times.
- Supervise campers in and around the water (pond and pool)
- Ensure that the Goodman Campus is kept clean, organized, and free of litter.
- Attend week-long orientation session.
- Be present and an active participant at all rallies and late-night programs.
- · Perform other duties as assigned.
