The Jewish Agency for Israel JAFI's Fund for Victims of Terror is providing immediate, critical financial aid to victims and their families.

JDC The American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee is caring for vulnerable seniors, people with disabilities, children and young adults at risk, families in financial distress, and the unemployed.

World ORT World ORT is providing STEAM education to thousands of students — including those displaced — in close partnership with schools/municipalities throughout Israel's periphery.

The Israel Trauma Coalition ITC operates 12 resilience centers, mostly in the Gaza border area, providing a seamless response between emergency preparedness, emergency, and recovery.

Barzilai Medical Center This 703-bed hospital is serving the city of Ashkelon, its environs, and the Gaza border region.

Ethiopian National Project During these times of emergency, ENP is providing crucial services to the Ethiopian Israeli community.

Emergency Volunteers Project Recruiting and training American firefighters, medical professionals, and other personnel to be deployed in Israel during emergencies.

Frontline Municipalities or Regional Councils Frontline communities are deeply challenged as they attend to the immense needs of their population, while rebuilding infrastructure, and restoring the sense of security, community, and routine.

The Israel Association for Child Protection Deals specifically and exclusively with all the various aspects of child abuse and trauma.

The Israel Association of Community Centers Through its community centers in the Gaza border area it is facilitating evacuations and transporting critical equipment needed by residents under fire.

The Israel Movement for Reform and Progressive Judaism Working with children at risk from the Gaza border area and other frontline areas who have been affected by the emergency.

The Israeli Volunteering Council Managing the work of over 40 national NGOs with over 200,000 volunteers together with the IDF Homefront Command.

Latet Providing food and hygiene kits to those most in need.

Leket Israel Providing meals to evacuees, senior citizens, and families from the hardest-hit areas of Israel.

Magen David Adom Providing emergency medical services across Israel.

Nefesh B'Nefesh Providing free counseling services to support families living in the South, parents of Lone Soldiers, bereaved Olim families, injured Lone Soldiers, and the general English-speaking population.

Soroka Medical Center Serving wounded first responders, soldiers, and civilians.

Tzohar Providing comfort and guidance to bereaved families, funeral ceremonies and Shiva services, emotional support, and a hotline.

United Hatzalah Emergency medical service operating across Israel.

ZAKA Rescue and recovery organization dealing with incidents of unnatural death.
