

2024 Republican National Convention National Special Security Event

Instructions Regarding Local Vehicle and Pedestrian Traffic Access Around Fiserv Forum, Panther Arena, and Baird Center During Event Closure

The procedures for vehicles accessing the Vehicle Screening Perimeter (Yellow Shaded Area) are as follows:

All drivers must have a valid driver's license rated for the vehicle they are operating.

All vehicles will be screened by Explosive Detection K9s and Explosive Ordnance Disposal personnel prior to entering the Vehicle Screening Perimeter at one of the following checkpoints:

- 6th Street / Vliet Street
- Water Street / State Street
- Michigan Street / Plankinton Avenue
- 9th Street / Wells Street
- 9th Street / Winnebago Street

No public vehicular access will be permitted within the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter (Red Shaded Area).

Please note, not all areas within these perimeters are accessible from every checkpoint. Please use the checkpoint closest to your destination.

The procedures for deliveries within the Vehicle Screening Perimeter (Yellow Shaded Area) are as follows:

All deliveries entering a United States Secret Service (USSS) security perimeter must go through the Remote Delivery Site (RDS) / Commercial Vehicle Screening site (CVS) located at 9th Street / St. Paul Avenue (adjacent to the Department of Natural Resources Building at 1027 W. St. Paul Avenue, Milwaukee, WI). This process will not exclude goods and services from being delivered but will delay the arrival. Transportation Vans equipped with a wheelchair lift/ramp will not need to go through RDS processing.

The RDS will be open Saturday, July 13, 2024, at 2000 hours and continue operations until the conclusion of the event at approximately Friday, July 19, 2024, at 0100 hours.

Upon completion of the screening process, all delivery vehicles will be sealed and escorted by law enforcement directly to a vehicle checkpoint. The vehicle checkpoint utilized will depend on the delivery location. Delivery vehicles will encounter police vehicles at either 6th and Clybourne, 9th and Winnebago, or 6th and Vliet where the driver/occupants of the delivery vehicle may be asked to state their purpose. If vehicles arrive at the checkpoint with a broken seal, they will be required to return to the RDS/CVS to be re-screened.

After a seal-check and any additional necessary sweeps of the vehicle and the driver by checkpoint personnel, the driver will be allowed to proceed to their respective delivery location.

All deliveries, trash services, etc., are expected to occur in the overnight and early morning hours.

Exigent circumstances will be considered and facilitated on a case-by-case basis.

The procedures for deliveries within the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter (Red Shaded Area) are as follows:

All deliveries entering the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter by USSS must go through the RDS/CVS located at 9th Street / St. Paul Avenue (adjacent to the Department of Natural Resources Building at 1027 W. St. Paul Avenue, Milwaukee, WI). This process will not exclude goods and services from being delivered but will delay the arrival.

The RDS will be open starting Saturday, July 13, 2024, at 2000 hours and continue operations until the conclusion of the event at approximately Friday, July 19, 2024, at 0100 hours.

Upon completion of the screening process, all delivery vehicles will be sealed and escorted by law enforcement directly to the vehicle checkpoint located at 6th Street and Michigan Street for delivery, where the driver/occupants of the delivery vehicle will be asked to state their purpose. If vehicles arrive at the checkpoint with a broken seal, they will be required to return to the RDS/CVS to be re- screened.

After a seal-check and any additional necessary sweeps of the vehicle and the driver by checkpoint personnel, the driver will be escorted by a USSS Uniformed Division Officer to their respective delivery location.

Delivery and delivery vehicles will be subject to vehicle freezes within the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter based on event schedules/timing.

Meals on Wheels/Doordash/Hot Food Delivery:

All drivers must have a valid driver's license rated for the vehicle they are operating.

All vehicles will be screened by Explosive Detection K9s and Explosive Ordnance Disposal personnel prior to entering the Vehicle Screening Perimeter (Yellow Shaded Area) at one of the following checkpoints:

- 6th Street / Vliet Street
- Water Street / State Street
- Michigan Street / Plankinton Avenue
- 9th Street / Wells Street
- 9th Street / Winnebago Street

No Meals on Wheels/Doordash/hot food delivery vehicular access will be permitted within the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter (Red Shaded Area).

For deliveries to the 550 Ultra Loft Condos, delivery drivers should park on Vliet Street, west of 6th Street prior to the vehicle checkpoint. Drivers should then walk their food delivery to the pedestrian gate located on the northeast corner of 6th / McKinley. Delivery drivers can then call the

recipient of the delivery and meet them at the pedestrian gate located at 6th / McKinley, on the northeast corner of the intersection to complete the delivery.

Rideshare/Taxi/Privately-Operated Vehicles:

Unfortunately, due to immutable security factors, we cannot accommodate passenger pickup or drop-off via private vehicle within the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter (Red Shaded Area).

Bicycles/Small Scooters/Golf Carts/Modes of Transportation That Do Not Use License Plates:

Bicycles will be able to enter the Vehicle Screening Perimeter (Yellow Shaded Area).

Bicycles, small scooters, and golf carts will NOT be able to enter the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter (Red Shaded Area).

Please obey local law enforcement and city ordinances with regards to the use or disuse of bicycles on the sidewalk. Additionally, please obey local regulations concerning the use of tables, chairs or other items impeding public ingress/egress on public sidewalks.

Residents of the 550 Ultra Loft Condos:

Residents may access their residences immediately adjacent to the Pedestrian Restricted Perimeter from the north only via 6th Street. Resident vehicles will be required to undergo a vehicle inspection / sweep at the vehicle checkpoint located at 6th / Vliet Street. Pedestrian access is available via a pedestrian gate at the northeast corner of 6th / McKinley Street. Residents will be asked to present identification and have their names confirmed on a list provided by 550 Ultra Loft Condos building management.

Residents driving their vehicles, following the sweep, will be able to park in the garage attached to their building. When departing via vehicle, residents can only depart to the north by exiting the vehicle checkpoint at 6th / Vliet. Residents will not be authorized to travel eastbound on McKinley past 5th Street, westbound on McKinley past 6th Street, or southbound on 6th Street past McKinley.

- Residents are permitted to have guests; however, non-resident guests must utilize the pedestrian gate at the northeast corner of 6th / McKinley. Residents will be required to meet their guest at the pedestrian access gate and escort their guest into the building.
- Please note, while sidewalks will remain open for pedestrian foot traffic only to access the building, there will be no stopping/standing authorized on the sidewalks surrounding the building.

Individuals providing medical-related services to residents of the 550 Ultra Loft Condos will be admitted. Construction or maintenance contractors will also be authorized; however, the contractor vehicle may require screening at RDS. In all cases, evidence of an appointment is requested.

Hotel guests within the Inner Perimeter (Trade Hotel):

Trade Hotel guests driving a personally owned vehicle should enter the Vehicle Screening Perimeter via the vehicle checkpoint located at 6th Street / Vliet Street. After the guest's vehicle is screened, s/he will be directed to park in the 5th Street Parking Garage. After parking, the guest should cross 5th Street and enter the Trade Hotel via the entrance located just east of the intersection of 5th Street / Juneau Street.

Trade Hotel guests arriving via taxi/rideshare/drop off should direct their driver to enter the Vehicle Screening Perimeter via the vehicle checkpoint located at 6th Street/Vliet Street. After the vehicle is screened, s/he should direct their driver to drop them at the pedestrian checkpoint located at the pedestrian gate located at the northeast corner of 6th / McKinley. After entering via the pedestrian gate, Trade Hotel guests should walk south on 5th Street and enter the hotel via the entrance located just east of the intersection of 5th Street / Juneau Street.
